ignore the *abuse* of it." And thus we find in camp, on the car and in the city but little abuse of whiskey by the Fourth Wisconsin boys. Their record is good. But one word about whiskey, it is a dangerous article to touch and the least touching the better.

The make-up of this regiment is of that class of men who work and take pride in their work, who are too honest *not* to work. The best class of men in the world are the useful men, and they are they who work.

We are thankful to have such men as we meet in the Fourth Wisconsin and that they have been among us and are our brothers.
