1. Johann 'Phillip'¹ Strieter¹ was born Abt. 1808 in Rheinfellen, Prussia², and died 11 Jul 1873 in New Berlin, Waukesha Co., WI (Accident. The wall of a well caved in and fell on him. It took 20 hours to dig him out.. He married **Catherina Immig** Bef. 1832 in Prussia. She was born 1809 in Prussia, and died Bet. 1860 - 1870 in New Berlin, Waukesha Co., WI.

Notes for Johann 'Phillip' Strieter:

Phillip and his family emigrated to Wisconsin 1839 according to information on the 1900 census for Peter J. Strieter. Their 4th living child, Catherine was born in Wisconsin about 1847. Catherine's age on the Sept. 21, 1850 Census of New Berlin is 3. All the information of Phillip & Catherine Strieter is from the 1850 census of New Berlin of Waukesha County in Wisconsin. A Catherine Kern (spelling?), 19, is living with the family, relationship unknown. There is an Evangelical & Reformed Church of New Berlin burial record for a Philipp Striedter, born Rheinfellen Prussia (no age given) Date: 11 July 1873. Death is listed as an accident. The wall of a well caved in and fell on him. It took 20 hours to dig him out. He was buried 13 July 1873. I believe this is our Phillip.

2. Phillip² Strieter (Johann 'Phillip'¹)⁷ was born Abt. 1832 in Rhein-Bollen Pfalz (Palatine) Bavaria, and died Aft. 1888. He married **(1) Maria Margrethe Waechter⁸** 21 Jan 1855 in New Berlin, Waukesha Co., WI⁹. She was born Abt. 1836 in Prussia, and died Unknown. He married **(2) Elizabeth Hoffmann** Bet. 1873 - 1880 in Missouri or Wisconsin. She was born Abt. 1833 in Ohio, and died 03 Oct 1888 in Milwaukee Co., WI at age 56.

Notes for Phillip Strieter:

Phillip Strieter, 18, is listed with his parents Phillip and Catherine Strieter on the 1850 census of New Berlin, Waukesha Co., WI.

The 1860 Milwaukee census has Phillip listed under STREITER, Philipp, 28, with

Margaretha, 25, Christine, 4, and Jacob, 9/12. His father is listed as Phillip Strater, 54, with Catherine, 52, and Christiana, 19, all born in Prussia are in the 1860 WI, Waukesha, New Berlin census.

Phillip, a farmer, & Margaret are listed on the 1870 OH, Knox Co., Jeddo twp. census. STREET is the spelling of the name, however it is located under STRUT. It indicates they own real estate worth \$3400. They have a daughter Christiana, 13, born in WI that is listed as omitted from line 9 of the family. Catherina, David, Elizabeth & Rosa are also listed born in MN.

The WI 1880 Census lists Phillip, 48 & Elizabeth, 47. His occupation is a retired farmer. His last name is spelled Strieder. David and Lizzie were born in Minnesota, I think possibly, in Winona. Lizzie's wedding certificate lists her birth place as Winona, MN. Anna was born in Knox Co., MO and then Caroline was born in Milwaukee, WI. Rosa isn't listed in the census, however, her marriage certificate lists her birth place as Missouri. Christiana is not listed and may be married?

Waukesha's Link to the Past lists a Phillip STRIEDER, resident of New Berlin, born in Rhein-Bollen Pfalz (Palatine) Bavaria married to WACHTER, Maria Margareth. A child Christina, born 16 Sept. 1856, baptized 28 Sept. 1856 with sponsors Wachter, Substitute Phil Immich & Christina Strieder by J.D. Huber (source: Old German Reformed Church New Berlin, WI)

Note: There are several different spellings of Phillip and Strieter throughout the different censuses.

Notes for Maria Margrethe Waechter:

WACHTER and WUECHTER are other spellings of Maria's maiden name. Maria's name is listed as Wachter: Maria Margretha in the Old German Reformed church records.

Marriage Notes for Phillip Strieter and Maria Waechter:

The Old German Reformed Church records of New Berlin, WI list STREETE: Philipp married to WACHTER: Maria Margretha and the witnesses were Johann Heinrich Muller & Jakob Wachter.

STRIEDER is also another spelling listed for Philipp.

This marriage information was found Feb. 1, 2007 on the Internet site, Links to the Past Waukesha, WI.

Notes for Elizabeth Hoffmann:

The 1880 Milwaukee, WI Census lists both Elizabeth's parents from France and that she was born in Ohio. The census also lists David, Lizzie, Anna & Caroline's mother as being born in Ohio. Also listed as a boarder is William Beers, 8, born in Kansas, his father born in N.Y. and his mother born in Ohio. William maybe be Elizabeth's son from a previous marriage?

Certificate of Death No. 21, lists Elizabeth Strieter as married, aged 56 yrs., 3 months, 0 days. Her father's name is listed as Hoffmann (?) born in the U.S. Mother's name is blank.

Elizabeth's place of birth is Ohio and her husband is Phillip Strieter. She died of acute dysentery for 9 days. She died at 507 15th St. in the 9th Ward. A call to the Calvary

cemetery on January 9, 2007 verified she was buried there under the last name spelled Stretier. She is in a single grave and no other family is buried there. Where is Phillip?

Notes for David Strieter:
A David Streeter is found in the 1900 WI, Milwaukee Co., Milwaukee City census as widowed and his occupation is a butcher. His address is 730 Germania St. listed between Seventh and Eighth Streets. This is the only listing I could find for him. His sister Carrie is also listed in the 1900 census as a Streeter.

Mrs. Charles Weir Succumbs After Stroke

Annie Martha Charlotte Strieter, wife of Charles Weir, was born in LaBelle, MO. March 29, 1872. In Milwaukee, Wisconsin she was united in holy wedlock to Mr. Charles Weir on September the 2nd 1893, the ceremony was performed by Rev. Hertz.

To this union were born one son, Irwin of Milwaukee and two daughters, Mrs. Charlotte Tucker of Racine, Wisconsin and Mrs. Violet Parchem of the town of Dellona.

Twenty five years ago they came to our vicinity and located on a farm in the Town of Dellona. The last four years they have been residents of our city.

Last Friday, November 19th, she became suddenly ill and was taken to the Reedsburg Hospital for treatment. She closed her eyes to this world Saturday, November 26th in the morning, reaching the age of 54 yrs., 7 months and 29 days,

She is survived by her husband, one son, two daughters and seven grandchildren, also four sisters, Mrs. Catherine Roberts of Hartford, Wisconsin, Mrs. Elizabeth Hassman of Milwaukee, Mrs. Rose C. Herman and Mrs. Caroline Kretschman, both of Milwaukee, and a host of friends.

The funeral was held Monday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock conducted by Rev. L. Schneider of the St. Johns Lutheran Church.

Charles William Weir, son of Wm. Weir and his wife Minna nee Mundt, was born the 16th day of June, 1866 in Pannurania, (Pomerania?klw) Germany, where he was baptized in the Lutheran Church. At the age of seven years he came with his parents to Milwaukee and attended the public and parochial school of that city, receiving a thorough instruction in the Christian doctrine and was confirmed in one of the Lutheran churches in Milwaukee.

The second day of September in the year 1893 he entered the state of holy matrimony with Miss Anna Strieter. This union was blessed with one son and two daughters.

About 30 years ago the family moved on a farm in the town of Dellona which became their permanent home until 1920 when the family retired from active farm work and moved to Reedsburg. Here the family became members of the St. John's Lutheran Church.

In the year of 1926 on the 26th day of November he lost his faithful wife. Since that time he made his home with his children. A week ago he became ill with an attack of influenza which developed into inflammation of the lungs. He passed away at the home of his son Irvin in the town of Dellona on Friday, November 13th at the age of 65 years, 4 months and 27 days.

He is survived by his son Irvin of Dellona and two daughters Mrs. Charlotte Tucker of Racine and Mrs. Violet Parchem of the town of Excelsior, 12 grandchildren, one brother August of Mill Valley, Calif., also three sisters, Mrs. Emma Henkel of Chicago, Miss Emilie Weir of Chicago, Mrs. Augusta Greeve of Chicago and three sisters-in-law, Mrs. Caroline Kretzman of Milwaukee, Mrs. Kate Roberts of Hartford, Mrs. Rose Herman of Milwaukee and many other relatives and friends.

The marriage license lists William's parents as Wm. Kretschmar & Emilie Butcher.
Carrie's parents are Philipp Strieter and Katherine Strieter. No maiden name for her. All Carrie's sister's marriage records list their mother as Marie/Mary Margrethe/Maggie Waechter/Wuechter. Witnesses were Max Franke and Lydia Kretschmar. The ceremony was performed by Geo. Heitz in Milwaukee.
Carrie was born in Milwaukee in February of 1873, which means, the Strieter's moved from Jeddo/LaBelle, Knox Co., Missouri between April 1872 and February of 1873. It is also possible Phillip's wife Elizabeth might have been Katherine Elizabeth. The 1900 census listing Carrie says her mother & father were born in Germany, so the question now is whether Katherine is Elizabeth or Maggie? Elizabeth was born in Ohio according to the 1880 census and her death record.
